The Details:

- **Paint-In Workshop:** Free! Just show up and bring your own materials. Outdoors, by the river behind library; dress appropriately.

- **Contest & Show:** Artworks must be plein-air in acrylic, oil, watercolor, ink or pastel; limit 3 images/artist; \$5/piece submitted. Ribbons will be awarded in each medium. Artist profiles should be printed to an 8.5x11 sheet of paper and dropped off with the artwork. All entries must be landscape related, showing some aspect of the Millers River, and be signed and ready to hang. Pick up artwork on June 30.
