



## **New Blue Trail Guide Map**

The Millers River Watershed Council (MRWC) has published a full-color Blue Trail Guide for the 6-mile Athol-Orange segment of the Millers River. The Guide covers the river between downtown Athol and downtown Orange, nearly the same course of the annual River Rat Race, and highlights a surprising variety of cultural and natural points of interest spanning hundreds and thousands of years. It's all here and much, much more--including several stops for paddlers wishing to take a break. This is a great way for families to quietly enjoy the river 364 days of the year.
